Directions for Administering Placement Tests

Use the following procedures to administer the placement tests:

- Have two copies of the placement tests (one test for the examiner and one test for the examinee), pencil and timer.
- Identify a part of the room or another setting where the child can read to you individually.
- Sit next to the child.
- Time the second and third test passage (note that the first test passage is untimed).
- Use the coding system when marking errors.
- Immediately following an error, tell student correct response.

Count all of the following as errors:

- 1. **Misidentification or word substitution**: child says the word incorrectly or substitutes a different word.
- 2. **Self-correction**: child says the word incorrectly but corrects the word without a prompt.
- 3. Sounds out: child sounds out a word correctly but doesn't say the word.
- 4. **Omission**: child leaves a word out/skips the word.
- 5. **Insertion:** child adds a word.
- 6. Hesitation: if the child does not identify a word after 4 seconds, tell the child the word.
- 7. **Reversal**: student reverses the position of two words ("rat that" for "that rat")

Do not count the following as errors:

- 1. **Repetition**: when a student correctly repeats a word or phrase, is not counted as an error.
- 2. Line-skipping: if student skips a line of text, point to the appropriate line and do not count it as an error.

Placement Criteria

For each test passage, the child should read the entire selection (other than the first test passage if the child is a nonreader). *If the child tells you that they cannot read when presented with the first test passage, say*, "That is OK, we are going to teach you!" *If the child says the name of each letter for the first few words on the first test passage, discontinue testing, and say*, "Thank you for doing your best! We are going to teach you to read!" Test Passage 1 is not timed. For the Second and Third Test Passages, record the total time it takes the child to read the entire selection. Mark each error on the test passage. The placement criteria and next steps are below and are listed at the bottom of each test passage.

I want you to do your best reading this story out loud. Use your finger to point to each word as you are reading to help you. If you cannot read some words, that is OK! We are going to teach you. If you do not know a word, I will tell you the word. Now, do your best, read carefully and start here. (Point to where the child should begin.)
