Note: # of words = total number of words in story; wpm = words per minute; errors are based on 97% accuracy criterion

Formula to find words per minute: Take the number of words read and divide by the student's time (in seconds). Multiply that number by 60. (For example: 77 words divided by 68 seconds = 1.13; $1.13 \times 60 = 67.8 \text{ wpm.}$)

Instructional decision guidelines based on wpm and error rate:

- If the student's wpm score is below criterion range or error rate exceeds maximum, provide more practice with difficult words and sentences. After firming with practice, have the student reread the story to determine if mastery criterion is met. Repeat the procedure until the student's wpm score and error rate both fall within mastery criteria range. Consult your facilitator for additional support when issues arise.
- If the student's wpm score and error rate are within criteria range, continue with lessons.
- If the student's wpm score is 1.5 times the criteria range and the student is within the error limit on three consecutive stories, test up by giving checkouts at 10 lesson intervals. Student can move up in lessons to the highest point of meeting passing criteria.
